Prior to joining CUIB, she served for twelve years as the Vicar general and the following six years as Superior General of the Sisters of St. Therese, Diocese of Buea; Prior to that she was the Principal of the prestigious college Christ The King College, Tiko for eleven years; teacher at the John Paul II Institute of Theology (JOPASIT); Registrar of Examination for the Secondary Schools in the Diocese of Buea; Project Coordinator for the Diocese of Buea; Secretary and President of the Conference of English Speaking-Religious of the Ecclesiastical Province of Bamenda (CESR) now known as Conference of Religious of the Ecclesiastical Province of Bamenda (CREPB) and Formation Director in her Congregation.
